Please submit only one application and one set of required attachments. One application with attachments serves as an application for all three scholarships. Eligibility for each scholarship is the same. To be eligible, the student must:

1. Be enrolled / accepted at the Roueche Graduate Center pursuing an Ed.D. in the Community College Leadership Program; and
2. Have a Master's degree or higher from a regionally accredited institution; and
3. Have a minimum GPA of 3.3; and
4. Applicant must be self-paying and **not be receiving financial support** (including tuition assistance or other forms of employer tuition reimbursement) from their home institutions.

Applications will be available commencing on or about **July 12, 2017** with an application **deadline of August 16, 2017**. Complete applications (with all attachments) are to be sent to the NAU Foundation by the deadline stated.¹

A complete application includes:

1. Application Form.
2. Brief autobiography (400 words or less) describing your career goals and objectives, involvement in extracurricular activities, financial need and any other pertinent information.

If you are utilizing **Federal Financial Aid** to assist with paying for your tuition, and if you are approved for this scholarship, it could affect the amount of Federal Financial Aid you are eligible to receive.
